Establishment of a database "EASC Alexandria digital library archive". Access via the EASC homepage

Reasons for the motion

Whether old EAS journals, technical papers, special tools, acknowledgements, pictures, press reports, free literature from coaching, supervision, management, therapy and counselling or special festivals and events, mostly such things can be found in the private libraries of the members. Over the years, some things are forgotten or lost. This is something that does not have to be the case!

Who would be better suited than an association to document these things in the long term, also for research purposes!

A section "Interviews Video-Audio Archive" would certainly be worthwhile, too, so that the historical memory of EASC is not lost.

Subject of the vote

The General Assembly may resolve

To set up a working group with the task of:

By the end of 2022, to create a concept for an expandable documentation system (history archive and working archive) that can also meet future requirements and to install it. The first step would be to set up a collection point to which members can send their documents or specimen copies.
