

The report on the work of the EASC institutes (September 2023 to September 2024)

1. Election of the new spokesperson:

- Christoph Schalk, Director of the Würzburg Academy for Empowerment Coaching, was elected as the new spokesperson for the institutes at the institute meeting in September 2023.

2. Institutes' meeting in February 2024:

- Another meeting took place on February 7, 2024 with 16 participants.
- A central point was the evaluation of a survey among the institutes in order to gather information about their existence, content, focus (supervision or coaching training), methods and approaches taught and marketing interests.

3. Rules of procedure:

- It was decided to draw up rules of procedure, which were developed and adopted by the end of April 2024.
- The EASC statutes stipulate that the institutional meeting must have rules of procedure, which had not been the case to date.

4. Reform process:

- At the meeting in February, the reform process was discussed and Daniel Frei presented the draft of the new manual.
- It was decided that the reform process would not be reflected in further institute meetings, but would be a separate process in which the representatives of the institutes would participate as far as possible.

5. Coaching training at Homodea:

- The discussion about coaching training at Homodea will no longer take place at the institute meeting, but as a separate process led by the Executive Board. However, the institute representatives will be involved in the discussions.

6. Planned institutes' meeting in September 2024:

- Three new institutes that have applied for recognition by the EASC will introduce themselves.

- The status of the reform, the impact on the institutions and the status at Homodea as well as opinions on the matter are exchanged.

The report shows the active involvement of the institutes in various processes and the introduction of rules of procedure as an important step towards structuring the work of the EASC institutes.
