SURVEY AMONG THE INSTITUTIONS

- In June 2024, the reform group conducted a survey among the institutes on the questions of the designation of the teaching trainer level and the question of gendering the manual.
- 13 institutes took part. The results were sent to the institutes and committees on 30.06.24.

SUMMARY

- Over time, the reform group (conservative estimation) invested an estimated 2000 hours of voluntary work in the reform process - not including the intensive work of Petra Lietz and the previous paid assistants.
- The reform group will conclude its work with the presentation of the new manual on 19.09.2024 and will be available for follow-up questions until 03.12.2024.
- The reform group emphasizes the draft status of the submitted manual, which still contains a number of open points that need to be clarified in the next version.
