CQS meetings:

Since the last General Assembly (September 2024), the CQS has held nine meetings. All meetings took place via Zoom and usually lasted between one and one and a half hours.

Specifically, we dealt with the following topics:

- 5 certifications as EASC supervisors
- 1 certification as a mentoring coach and mentoring supervisor
- 3 certifications as EASC trainers
- 111 recognitions of LTC graduates (homodea) as EASC coaches 2024/2025 after completion of the mentoring supervision workshops
- Application and recognition of institutes and curricula:
 - 2 onboarding processes for coaching institutes
 - Gordon & TA Training and Consulting Ltd, Budapest
 - Coaching Institut Dresden, Dr. Ulla Nagel
- Recognition of examinations:
 - 14 approvals of examinations at EASC institutes in the field of coaching and supervision.
