Subject <i>Title of the motion/proposal</i>	a. Revision of the Articles of Association in Sections 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8a, and 9 b. Authorization of the Executive Board to resolve any objections to the draft of the Statutes of the Association by the registry court or the tax office.
Reasons for the motion / proposal	a. Further developments within the association have made it necessary to revise and amend the articles of association. For example, organizational development was previously missing, but is now part of the new manual. In addition, parts of the articles of association have been spun off into rules of procedure. These are only regulations that concern cooperation and do not need to be part of the articles of association. This allows the committees to respond more quickly to changes. b. The authorization of the Executive Board is intended to ensure that, in the event of any objections to the draft statutes by the registry court or the tax office, no extraordinary general meeting needs to be convened, but rather the Executive Board can decide on the required changes.
Subject of the vote <i>Please formulate here the resolution to be voted on.</i>	The General Assembly may resolve: a. To accept the amendments to the Articles of Association in the form indicated. b. If the registry court or the competent tax office raises objections in connection with the adopted amendment to the Articles of Association, the Executive Board is authorized to make the necessary amendments to the Articles of Association by way of a resolution of the Executive Board in order to remedy the objection. In doing so, the Executive Board must take into account the requirements of the registry court and the tax office and may only make changes that serve exclusively to remedy the objection. Such changes must be reported at the next general assembly.
