

Electoral regulations

Election Procedure

The electronic voting software eBallot is used to conduct elections and votes at General Assemblies.

Every member who has registered for the general meeting will receive the access data for the eBallot voting tool.

Votes can only be cast after registration. Registration closes 48 hours before the General Assembly. eBallot guarantees that votes are cast secretly and cannot be traced.

Vote delegation

Votes may be delegated to other members. Each member may take on a maximum of 3 votes. The delegation of votes must be sent to the Office electronically at least 48 hours before the General Assembly.

Voting rights

Each full member has one vote.

Full members are individual members (full members) and institutes.

This means that each institute has one vote. Institute operators also have one vote as individual members. The second teaching trainer must cast his or her own vote.

The prerequisite for exercising voting rights is that the membership fee has been fully paid.

Universities and cooperation partners are not entitled to vote.
